Mt Hood

90 minutes east of Portland
Basecamps: Welches, Government Camp

Columbia River Gorge

Western end: 30 minutes east of Portland
Eastern end: About 2 hours west of Pendleton
Basecamps: Hood River, The Dalles

The Wallowas

Wallowa Lake is 3.5 hours northwest of Ontario; 2.5 hours east of Pendleton
Basecamps: Joseph, Enterprise, La Grande, Baker City

Painted Hills

2 hours east of Bend; 4.5 hours west of Ontario
Basecamps: Mitchell, Fossil, John Day, Prairie City

Smith Rock

About 30 minutes north of Bend; 3 hours north of Klamath Falls; 3 hours south of Portland
Basecamps: Redmond, Sisters, Bend, Sunriver

Crater Lake

5.5 hours north of Sacramento; 4.5 hours south of Portland
Basecamps: Klamath Falls, Ashland, Medford. Other towns en route: Roseburg, Grants Pass, Jacksonville

Cycling: Discover Oregon's 13 Scenic Bikeways, miles of mountain biking and gravel trails, plus Bike Friendly Businesses. Visit rideoregonride.com
