# **Bradley International Airport (BDL) factsheet**



#### Overview

- Norwegian already serves 8 major US cities but to offer passengers even greater choice and ground-breaking fares, new transatlantic routes are also being added to smaller US airports
- With good access into major cities but much lower landing charges, these airports allow
  Norwegian to offer some truly affordable fares that will allow as many people as possible to fly
- **Bradley International** in **Hartford, Connecticut is a gateway to New England** Norwegian will offer three weekly transatlantic flights from **Edinburgh**

## **Airport Facilities**

Bradley International is New England's second largest gateway:

- **Brand new service enhancements** recently opened including a new airport lounge, duty free shop and Phillips Seafood restaurant
- Terminals are open 24 hours a day
- More than 20 food and beverage outlets incl. coffee shops, newsstands, bars and restaurants
- **17 hotels at the airport and nearby** including Sheraton, Days Inn and DoubleTree most provide courtesy shuttle service

### **Transport options**

Bradley International is the nearest airport for many New England communities and offers road, bus and rail links to Greater New England:

- Road and Car Hire: 2hr drive from Boston. All major car hire companies are available
- Train: Amtrak services from Windsor Locks and Windsor stations
- **Bus:** Connecticut Transit route 30 provides an express service to downtown Hartford (One way fare is \$1.75, Hourly services seven days per week) while Connecticut Transit route 34 connects Bradley with the towns of both Windsor and Hartford
- **Taxi:** Taxi Fares to the most frequently travelled towns around Bradley are Hartford \$45.00; East Hartford \$42.00; and West Hartford: \$42.00

#### Tourism and local area

As well as being a gateway to New England, Bradley International provides access to many attractions within easy driving distance:

- The 1874 Mark Twain House and Museum in Hartford author of Huckleberry Finn
- New England Air Museum (at Bradley International Airport)
- Numerous specialty food trails in Connecticut
- Newly-opened Connecticut Convention Centre, just minutes away from the airport offering key business opportunities
